Phi Alpha Theta Midwest Regional Meeting

20-21 April 2023

The Department of History at the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater is proud to host the 2023 Midwest Regional Phi Alpha Theta Conference on Friday, April 21, 2023. The conference will provide an opportunity for undergraduate and graduate historians to present their research in a collegial and professional environment. Dr. Jeffrey Engel, Director of the Center for Presidential History at Southern Methodist University, will deliver the keynote address, “The New Cold War: What Went Wrong?” at 7pm on Thursday, 20 April. The conference will take place the morning and early afternoon of Friday, 21 April. It will be followed by a barbeque and awards ceremony.

We invite Phi Alpha Theta members to submit proposals that address any region, period, or historical theme. Students are encouraged to present projects and papers that they have completed in previous courses as well as preliminary research findings in their current research. Phi Alpha Theta faculty advisors are encouraged to accompany their scholars to UW-Whitewater, attend their presentations, and assist as panel chairs and commenters as needed.

Proposals and a \$25 registration fee are due by Wednesday, April 5, 2023. Attendees may stay on campus overnight for an additional \$40. The registration link can be found online [here](#). To submit your research proposals, fill out [this](#) form. Proposals should include the student’s name, email address, institution, status (undergraduate or graduate), paper title, and an abstract of up to 250 words. Presentations will be organized into panels based on common themes, topics, or regions. Your presentation should be no longer than 10 to 15 minutes long. Additionally, if you would like your work to be considered for an award, you must submit your 10-12 page paper in Word format in the research proposal form.
