Alabama Regional Meeting of Phi Alpha Theta

Saturday, February 25, 2023

The Department of History and World Cultures at Auburn University at Montgomery is pleased to announce that it will host the 2023 Alabama Regional Meeting for Phi Alpha Theta on February 25, 2023. The conference provides opportunities for undergraduate and graduate students of history to present their research in a professional environment.

Proposals may address any region, period, or historical theme. Students are encouraged to present projects and papers that they have completed in previous courses as well as preliminary research findings in courses that are being conducted during the fall term.

Presenters are not required to be members of Phi Alpha Theta in order to present and participate, but members of Phi Alpha Theta are eligible to receive awards for papers of exceptional quality.

Students should submit their proposals as abstracts of no more than 250 words to their chapter advisor by December 7, 2022. We ask that faculty advisors forward the proposals electronically as a single Word document to mburger1@aum.edu. Papers will be selected and organized into sessions based upon the abstract. Presentations should be around 15 minutes long or 8-9 pages (1500-2000 words). Students then must submit their papers to their chapter advisor at least two weeks before the February conference.

The conference will be held at Taylor Center and Goodwyn Hall on AUM's campus. The registration fee for participation is \$30, payable by check or cash either in advance or at the conference. Registration will open at 8 am. Lunch and refreshments will be provided. Directions, maps, and additional information will be provided as the conference approaches.

The conference will also follow Auburn University at Montgomery's University's current masking policies; at this point masks are optional. Should the policy change by the time of the conference, chapter advisors will be informed. By participating in the conference, all attendees agree to abide by whatever masking policies are in place when the conference begins.
