We invite paper proposals from undergraduate and graduate Phi Alpha Theta members at all participating Hawai'i campuses. Eligible papers will be judged for prizes. Please note that new members are encouraged to join and participate.

Students who wish to give a paper presentation at the Regional Conference should submit a 500-word abstract to patmanoa@hawaii.edu by **Sunday, February 12, 2023**. Be sure to include your name, your email address, your school, and the title of the presentation. Please also indicate if you are an undergraduate or graduate student.

If students wish to have their conference paper evaluated for a paper prize, please note that the competition will be limited to the paper to be delivered at the conference. There is a word limit of 3,000 excluding citations (or 12 pages of double-spaced text, excluding citations). To be eligible for competition, full papers must be submitted to patmanoa@hawaii.edu by **Sunday, March 12, 2023**.
