## Call for Papers

### Tennessee Regional Meeting of Phi Alpha Theta

Friday and Saturday, March 31 and April 1, 2023

The East Tennessee State University Department of History's Alpha Epsilon Epsilon chapter of Phi Alpha Theta proudly announces that the chapter will host the 2023 Tennessee Regional Conference on March 31 and April 1, 2023. The conference provides opportunities for undergraduate and graduate students of history to present their research in a friendly, professional environment.

We invite students to submit proposals that address any region, period, or historical theme. Students are encouraged to present projects and papers that they have completed in previous courses as well as preliminary research findings from current courses or projects. All students of history are encouraged to present and participate, but only members of Phi Alpha Theta are eligible to compete for awards.

A proposal should include the student's name (as it will appear on conference materials), email address, institution, status (undergraduate or graduate), PAT membership status (member or not), paper title, and an abstract of up to 250 words. Students should submit proposals to their chapter advisor, who will then forward proposals electronically as a single Word (docx) document to Dr. Tom Lee at [phialphatheta@etsu.edu](mailto:phialphatheta@etsu.edu). Additionally, in the correspondence conveying the proposal(s), advisors may indicate their willingness to serve as session moderators or judges for the conference. To be considered for inclusion, proposals are due no later than February 24, 2023.

Papers and presentations will be selected and organized into sessions based upon themes determined from the abstracts. Presentations should be no more than 10 to 15 minutes long, with time allotted for moderator comments and audience questions. Papers should be no more than 8-9 pages double-spaced (1,500-2,000 words). In order to be eligible for awards, final papers must be submitted by the chapter advisor in Word (docx) format to [phialphatheta@etsu.edu](mailto:phialphatheta@etsu.edu) by Tuesday, March 24, 2023.
